



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

October 19, 2017

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, October 19, 2017. The agenda included the following items:

- The District's financial status is strong and in good condition with three months remaining the year.
- Elizabeth Gray was sworn in to fill the unexpired term of Position 5.
- Plans for the District's Public Hearing on November 27, 2017 are on track.
- The Budget & Finance Committee distributed a draft 2018 Budget.
- Branding
 - The next five gateway markers are in the permit process.
 - Six METRO bus shelters were re-wrapped with the District's special artwork panels and have not been vandalized.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The Network of Commercial Property Owners had a good turn out and a presentation from Houston Police Department.
 - Owners are concerned that arrested individuals are released through personal recognizance bonds and resume criminal activities at the same locations.
 - Planning is underway for the Business Network Celebration in December to highlight progress and recognize new developments and improvements.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - The White Oak Pool is closed for the season.
- Public Safety and Security
 - National Night Out was a success despite inclement weather.
 - Multifamily owners and managers are being encouraged to envision the caliber they desire in future residents and to improve their properties to attract them.
 - Multifamily communities are also encourage to attain Blue Star certification.
