



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

February 16, 2017

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, February 16, 2017. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports on assessments and the District's financial status, reflecting that the District is in good financial condition.
- Consultant James Noteware briefed the Board on progress made and necessary next steps to revitalize the Antoine Corridor.
- Branding
 - Planning is moving forward for the next five gateway markers.
 - Multifamily communities are being contacted to arrange to present the "Clean the Nest in Near Northwest" campaign at their residents' meetings. The campaign encourages taking pride in the area, reducing and preventing littering, and discouraging vandalism.
 - The corridor streetscape study continues, working with both the City of Houston and with Harris County Precinct One on road projects.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The owners network meetings have created improved communication with commercial owners and between owners in the District.
 - The code inspection program is getting positive responses from most property owners.
 - The next Business Network Breakfast is on March 2; District Attorney Kim Ogg will be the speaker.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Event bookings are increasing.
- Public Safety and Security
 - The most recent meeting featured an informative presentation by Harris County Public Health on the Zika virus and challenges in controlling its spread.
