



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

May 18, 2017

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, May 18, 2017. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports on assessments and the District's financial status, reflecting that the District is in good financial condition.
- The Board received and approved the Fiscal Year 2017 Financial Statements Report. The audit team issued an unqualified opinion on the District's financial records.
- Branding
 - Streetscape enhancements have been included in the Harris County Precinct 1 Antoine North rebuild project plans. This streetscape plan will be the basis for future enhancements within the District.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The Board approved moving forward with exploration and development of approaches to promote the growth and/or redevelopment of underperforming commercial properties in the District.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - The White Oak Pool will open for the 2017 season on May 27th. Pool memberships are being marketed.
 - The Blue Marlins Swim Team (youth) hosted its first meet of the season.
- Public Safety and Security
 - The Job Fair had 30 employers offering open positions, and more than 300 job seekers of all skills and experience levels. One agency sent 30 job seekers for further interviews.
- Membership
 - Dan Nankani and Gene Cripps attended their first Board Meeting.
 - The Board voted to renew the terms for all Directors in Positions 1 through 5, effective June 1st.
