



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

September 20, 2018

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, September 20, 2018. The agenda included the following items:

- The Budget & Finance Committee has begun planning for the 2019 Budget.
- The Board approved a 2018 assessment rate of \$0.132 for the seventh consecutive year.
- Branding
 - Staff met with Commissioner Cagle and his staff to finalize designs for the monument markers. Work continues to secure permits for Phase 2 of the monument marker program.
 - In planning phase for implementation of mini-murals project approved in August.
- Economic and Business Development Committee
 - Working to explore options for code enforcement within the District.
 - Met with Aldine ISD leadership to explore ways to improve the appearance of Eisenhower Senior High School to align with improvements in the area.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Houston ISD Athletics Department has scheduled their fall track meet- their first booking.
 - The 2018 pool season has ended. Memberships increased over 2017.
- Public Safety & Security
 - The Harris County Sheriff's Department's Citizen's Police Academy, a fifteen-week course, has begun at the White Oak Conference Center.
 - National Night Out is set for October 2nd. This is the District's largest event, and the largest in the area.
