



NNMD Directors' Discussion Summary

June 15, 2017

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors regular meeting was scheduled for Thursday, June 15, 2017, but did not achieve a quorum. Directors took no action but discussed the following:

- The assessment consultant reported the status of assessment collections.
- Representatives from The Goodman Corporation presented a summary of work completed and planned.
- Branding
 - Streetscape enhancements have been incorporated in the Harris County Precinct 1 Antoine North rebuild project plans.
 - The gateway markers (phase 2) plans are being reviewed before submission for permits review.
 - Staff will coordinate with METRO to install branded panels in select shelters.
- Economic and Business Development
 - While the Code Inspection Program has been successful to date, some properties remain in very poor condition.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Events bookings are strong, with multiple events on three of the last six weekends.
- Membership
 - Members are developing recommendations concerning committee structure and membership.
- Public Safety and Security
 - Law enforcement agencies are focused on several developing “hotspots” in the area.
 - Graffiti was removed from 11 sites in May
 - 2,650 pounds of litter were removed in May; this reflects 26 pounds per mile cleaned.
- Director Kilpatrick announced that there would be no meeting in July.
