April 15, 2021

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met by web conference in regular session on Thursday, April 15, 2021. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor, delinquent assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance Committee
 - The process of changing banking relationships has begun.
- Branding
 - Expansion of the mini murals project is moving forward.
 - Enhancements and improvements to the District's website and social media posts are increasing use of the website.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The W Little York Sidewalk Project is in the bid phase. Maintenance agreements with Harris County and Harris County Flood Control District have been executed.
 - Planning is underway for the virtual Business Network Breakfast in June.
 - The District is asking commercial property owners to consider installing holiday lighting for 2021.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - The Center's website and social media posts are promoting booking opportunities. Several events are scheduled, and inquiries are frequent.
 - The new pool management company has been engaged.
 - The (virtual) Spring Plant Sale was a great success. Orders were placed online through a new ecommerce site and then picked up on April 9th and 10th.
 - The Blue Marlins (youth) Swim Team has begun their practice sessions.

 - Planning has begun for National Night Out on October 5th.
 - The District has filled the position of Director of Public Safety & Field Services.
