



NNMD Board of Directors Discussion Summary

January 15, 2026

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors held its regular meeting on Thursday, January 15, 2026 but did not achieve a quorum. The Directors present discussed the following items but took no actions:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
 - District financials were reviewed.
- Branding
 - Coordination of website and social media posts continues to promote businesses, activities and District initiatives.
 - Extensive social media posts supported civic engagement, local activities and District efforts, as well as promotion of the White Oak Conference Center as an event space.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The District awarded *Innovation Awards* in December to Amogy, Alaia Crossing, YES Prep White Oak Elementary School and Lone Star College (Victory).
 - Planning is underway for the Business Network Breakfast on March 5th.
 - The W Tidwell sidewalk project is paused for the railroad crossing work.
 - The Bingle/W Tidwell intersection project awaits streetlight work.
 - Plans are complete for the N Houston Rosslyn HSIP project and bid package materials are being prepared.
 - The West Little York Safe Routes to School sidewalk project is in the early planning phase. Subcontractors are engaged and survey and coordination work underway.
 - Pending funding requests and upcoming opportunities were reported.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Event inquiries continue to come in.
 - The Toy Drive was a tremendous success with strong support from our businesses.
- Security
 - The 2025 National Night Out was recognized by National Association of Town Watch for community engagement and public safety collaboration.
 - Constables focused on commercial vehicle enforcement and organized retail crime.
- The next Board Meeting will be February 19, 2026.
