



## NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

June 16, 2022

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in person and by web conference in regular session on Thursday, June 16, 2022. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
  - The District’s finances are in good shape.
- Branding
  - Progress is being made in painting the nine mini murals in phase 3.
  - Implementation of the 2022 Marketing Plan is being finalized.
- Economic and Business Development
  - The June 2<sup>nd</sup> Business Network Breakfast presentation by Houston Public Works on the Antoine Drive Rebuild was well-attended and highly informative.
  - The W Little York Sidewalk Project is in the punch list phase of substantial completion.
  - Staff and consultants continue preparation of several projects for funding consideration.
  - The Business Directory and Map updates should go into print in October.
- White Oak Conference Center
  - Inquiries and bookings are increasing.
  - White Oak Pool season is open and memberships are growing.
  - The Blue Marlins Swim Team shifted their practices to mornings and held their final swim meet of the season at the White Oak Pool. Their season ends July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Security
  - The May joint initiative continued the focus on violent crimes and narcotics activities.
  - The District is developing a partnership with HPD’s Multifamily PIP meeting.
  - In May, 33 graffiti sites were abated, 5,650 pounds of trash were picked up and 140 bandit signs were removed.
