



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

May 18, 2023

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in person and by web conference in regular session on Thursday, May 18, 2023. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Upma Goyal with PNB Enterprises was sworn in for the unexpired term of Position 5.
- Budget & Finance
 - The District's finances are in good shape and the investment account is earning interest income.
- Branding
 - The final two mini murals should be completed this month.
 - Website and social media posts are coordinated to support Marketing goals and to promote local businesses.
 - Staff continue to work with the City's design team to incorporate the streetscape design.
- Economic and Business Development
 - Invitations have gone out for the June 1st Business Network Breakfast with HCAD Chief Appraiser Roland Altinger.
 - Repairs to the W Little York Sidewalk Project are about 60% complete.
 - Coordination with agencies and homeowners continues for the W Tidwell sidewalk project.
 - Construction has begun on improvements at Aron Ledet and Forest West Parks.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Bookings for corporate and social events continue.
 - Harris County Flood Control District held a preconstruction public meeting for the Inwood Forest Stormwater Detention Basin project.
 - Blue Marlins Swim Team season continues.
- Membership Committee
 - The Board re-elected Directors Jay Shani, Jerry Young, Quentin Wright and Dan Nankani and elected Maurice Davis (Akzo Nobel/International Paint) to terms effective June 1st.
- Security
 - The Constables patrol focused on traffic enforcement.
 - The monthly Crime Deterrence for Apartments and Businesses (C-DAB) continues.
 - Additional camera locations are being considered.
 - In April, the District abated 5 graffiti sites, delittered 112 miles of right-of-way, and removed 4,150 pounds of trash and 143 bandit signs.
 - The National Night Out Planning Committee is organizing this important event on October 3rd.
- Other Items
 - The Business Network Breakfast on September 7th will feature a mayoral candidates forum.
