



NNMD Board of Directors Discussion Summary

May 21, 2026

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors held its regular meeting on Thursday, May 21, 2026. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
 - District financials were reviewed and are in good shape.
 - The District closed the sale of struck off properties.
- Branding
 - Coordination of website and social media posts continues to promote businesses, activities and District initiatives.
 - The spring radio ads are wrapping up.
 - Extensive social media posts supported civic engagement, local activities and District efforts, as well as promotion of the White Oak Conference Center as an event space.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The June 4th Business Network Breakfast will focus on the District’s capital projects.
 - The W Tidwell sidewalk project railroad crossing work will finish in June.
 - The Bingle/W Tidwell intersection project construction is complete.
 - Plans and the project manual are finalized for the N Houston Rosslyn HSIP project. City Council approved the interlocal agreement.
 - Design is underway for the West Little York Safe Routes to School sidewalk project.
 - N Houston Rosslyn Phase 2 sidewalks and intersection improvements project is under design, with recent CDBG funding awarded by Harris County.
 - Pending funding requests were reported.
 - Commercial and residential permits were discussed.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Event bookings and inquiries continue.
 - The 2026 White Oak Pool season kicks off Memorial Day weekend.
- Security
 - Constables focused on deterring criminal activity on commercial properties.
- The next Board Meeting will be June 18, 2026.
