



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

October 16, 2025

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors held its regular meeting on Thursday, October 16, 2025. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor, delinquent assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
 - District financials were reviewed.
- Branding
 - Coordination of website and social media posts continues to promote businesses, activities and District initiatives.
 - The Fall radio campaign focused on driving traffic to the District’s website.
 - Data showed a 29% increase in direct searches for the website, and an overall 56% increase in web traffic.
 - Extensive social media posts supported civic, area and District activities.
- Economic and Business Development
 - Planning is underway for the Business Network Celebration on December 4th.
 - Construction on the W Tidwell sidewalk project is wrapping up.
 - The N Houston Rosslyn HSIP project is ready for TxDOT review upon full execution of all funding agreements.
 - The “W Little York 2” sidewalk project funding is pending federal budget reconciliation; the project should begin design this year.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Event inquiries continue to come in.
- Security
 - The Constables conducted school zone enforcement with Aldine ISD Police Department.
 - Constables, HPD, Harris County Fire Marshall and TABC executed a search warrant for after-hours alcohol sales, cocaine distribution and illegal gaming, making a number of arrests.
 - In September, the District removed 4,250 pounds of trash and 177 “bandit” signs. Graffiti was abated for 16 sites.
 - National Night Out was a resounding success, attracting nearly 3,200 attendees and bringing together residents, multiple law enforcement agencies and community partners for an evening of public safety awareness.
