



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

September 18, 2025

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors held its regular meeting on Wednesday, September 18, 2025. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
 - District financials were reviewed.
 - The Board approved the 2026 Budget.
 - The Board voted to leave the assessment rate at \$.139 per \$100 valuation for 2025.
 - The Board set the Annual Public Hearing for Monday, December 1, 2025 at 8:00 am.
- Branding
 - Coordination of website and social media posts continues to promote businesses, activities and District initiatives.
 - The Fall radio campaign is running.
- Economic and Business Development
 - Planning is underway for the Business Network Celebration on December 4th. In addition to the *Grow Near Awards*, the District will have a big kick-off event.
 - Construction on the W Tidwell sidewalk project and the Bingle/W Tidwell HSIP intersection improvement project is wrapping up.
 - The N Houston Rosslyn HSIP project is ready for TxDOT review upon full execution of the funding agreement.
 - The “W Little York 2” sidewalk project funding paperwork is moving forward; the project should begin design this year.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - White Oak Pool season wrapped up.
- Security
 - The Constables enforced commercial vehicle regulations.
 - In August, the District removed 4,900 pounds of trash and 240 “bandit” signs. Graffiti was abated for 12 sites.
