



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

September 16, 2021

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in person and by web conference in regular session on Thursday, September 16, 2021. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District’s assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- The 2021 roll includes \$117M in new construction and change of use values.
- Budget & Finance
 - The 2021 assessment rate was adopted, remaining unchanged at \$.139 per \$100 value.
 - The annual Public Hearing was set for November 29, 2021 at 8 am.
- Branding
 - Expansion of the mini murals project is moving forward.
 - The 2021 Marketing Plan implementation to date includes installation of three billboards and radio spots scheduled throughout September.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The W Little York Sidewalk Project is moving along.
 - Potential projects development is underway, anticipating grant funding opportunities.
 - The administrative process was completed to set up the recently awarded METRO grant funds for sidewalks on the north side of W Tidwell between Antoine and TC Jester.
 - Staff are working with City staff to incorporate streetscape design elements in the Antoine Drive rebuild plans.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Inquiries and bookings are increasing.
 - The White Oak Pool season has been very successful; the Pool is open weekends only through September.
- Public Safety & Security
 - The Constables targeted school zones to remind drivers to slow down.
 - An NNMD security camera captured footage of a homicide; HPD is using the footage in their investigation.
