The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, November 15, 2018. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board approved the 2019 Budget 15.
- Branding
 - o Work continues to secure permits for Phase 2 of the monument marker program.
 - Staff is working on implementation of the mini-murals project.
- Economic and Business Development Committee
 - o Planning for the Business Network Celebration and Grow Near Awards is coming along.
 - This District submitted a funding request to Houston-Galveston Area Council under the
 2018 Call for Projects for the Alabonson Park Shared Use Paths project.
 - o BB&T Bank will be opening a new branch in the District in 2019.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Fall cross-country track meets have wrapped up.
 - Two weddings will close out this year's event bookings. This has been a very busy year at the White Oak Conference Center.
- Public Safety & Security
 - The District is collecting Project 365 survey responses and will identify the "top" concern and develop a multidisciplinary plan to address that concern.
 - The Toy Drive is in full swing with many local businesses setting up collection boxes.
 - The District installed a security camera at the Antoine/De Soto intersection. Law enforcement is already reporting a big decrease in loitering at this corner.
