

Title VI Public Notice

The Near Northwest Management District (d.b.a. NNMD) hereby gives public notice that it is the NNMD's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with NNMD. Any such complaint must be in writing or by phone and filed with the NNMD Civil Rights Coordinator within one hundred-eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. Civil Rights Discrimination Complaint Forms may be obtained from this office at no cost to the complainant by calling 713-895-8021.

If you would like to file with Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Regional Office, please send a written complaint to FTA Region VI, 819 Taylor Street, Room 8A36, Fort Worth, TX 76102. A complainant may also file a complaint directly with the FTA by filing a complaint with the Office of Civil Rights, Attention: Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building, 5th Floor-TCR, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590.
