NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary



June 15, 2023

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in person and by web conference in regular session on Thursday, June 15, 2023. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Budget & Finance
 - The District's finances are in good shape and the investment account is earning interest income.
- Branding
 - The final two mini murals should be completed this month.
 - Website and social media posts are coordinated to support Marketing goals and to promote local businesses.
 - o The Board approved implementation of the 2023 Marketing Plan.
 - o Staff continue to work with the City's team to incorporate the streetscape design.
- Economic and Business Development
 - Steve Atchison with HCAD spoke on the property valuation process at the June Business Network Breakfast.
 - Coordination with the City and homeowners continues for the W Tidwell sidewalk project.
 - o A full application was submitted to TxDOT for the proposed W Little York 2 sidewalk project.
 - Construction has begun on improvements at Aron Ledet and Forest West Parks.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Bookings for events continue.
 - The White Oak Pool season has opened and membership sales are going well.
- Security
 - The Constables patrol focused on traffic enforcement.
 - o The monthly Crime Deterrence for Apartments and Businesses (C-DAB) continues.
 - In May, the District abated 11 graffiti sites, delittered 120 miles of right-of-way, and removed 4,500 pounds of trash and 189 bandit signs.
 - The District is issuing "Lock it, Hide it, Take it" signage to deter burglary of motor vehicles.
