

## NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

## May 16, 2019

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, May 16, 2019. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- The Board approved the 2018 Financial Statements report issued by Breedlove & Co., PC. The audit firm issued a "clean" opinion.
- Branding
  - Permits have been issued for phase 2 of the monument marker program, and the notice to proceed issued to the contractor.
  - o The Committee reviewed artists' renderings for the mini-murals project.
- Economic and Business Development
  - There was a long discussion about how Opportunity Zone investments could impact the Antoine Corridor's redevelopment.
  - o The W Little York Sidewalk and Bike Trail project could move into final design this fall.
- White Oak Conference Center
  - The Spring Plant Sale was very successful.
  - The pilot program for maintaining "back of curb" areas and clearing gutters on major roadways has begun.
- Public Safety & Security
  - Two additional surveillance cameras have been installed, and two more locations are being considered.
