



## NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

August 15, 2019

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, August 15, 2019. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor, delinquent assessments advisor and bookkeeper.
- Branding
  - The Phase 2 monument markers have been fabricated and the project is moving forward.
  - Designs and locations for the mini murals have been approved and the artists are being scheduled.
- Economic and Business Development
  - The funding transfer for the W Little York sidewalks and bike trail project is making progress. The District hopes to execute a design contract in the next few months.
  - The TxDOT Safe Routes to School application will be submitted on August 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Committee recommended, and the Board approved a motion to engage a consultant to develop a response to a request regarding future economic development opportunities and to submit the resulting document.
- White Oak Conference Center
  - The pilot program for maintaining "back of curb" areas has been extended through December.
  - The White Oak Pool season will end Labor Day.
- Public Safety & Security
  - The Public Safety and Apartment Managers meetings were combined and had a good turnout.
  - National Night Out is coming up on October 1<sup>st</sup> and planning is well underway, with 24 booth commitments.
