

NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

September 18, 2019

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, September 19, 2019. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Jerry Skweres was sworn in as a Director. Director Skweres is with Forged Products.
- Budget & Finance Committee
 - The Committee will recommend a 2019 Assessment Rate at a Special Meeting that will be called soon.
- Branding
 - The Phase 2 monument markers have permitting issues.
 - Painting the mini murals is underway and should be completed in the next several weeks.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The funding transfer for the W Little York sidewalks and bike trail project is making progress. The District hopes to execute a design contract in the next few months.
 - The TxDOT Safe Routes to School application was submitted on August 15th.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - o The White Oak Pool had a successful season. Memberships increased by 50%.
- Public Safety & Security
 - The combination Public Safety/Apartment Managers meeting had a good turnout and discussion of local crime issues.
 - o There is an uptick in "nuisance crimes" and speeding in school zones is an issue.
 - National Night Out is coming up on October 1st and planning is well underway, with 50 booth commitments and numerous public safety organizations participating.
