



NNMD Board of Directors Meeting Summary

January 16, 2020

The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, January 16, 2020. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Branding
 - The Phase 2 monument markers have been installed; irrigation and planting should be completed soon.
 - All ten mini murals in phase 1 of the mini murals project have been painted. A family friendly bike tour is being planned for February 1, 2020. Mini Murals Phase 2 planning is underway.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The Business Network Celebration and *Grow Near* Awards in December went very well.
 - A decision on the TxDOT Safe Routes to School application is expected in early 2020.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - Inquiries, tours and event bookings have been steady.
 - Tree and shrub trimming on Antoine from Pinemont to Victory is complete. NNMD has permission to trim the trees and shrubs along Antoine from W Gulf Bank to SH 249 and the contractor will start that work soon.
- Public Safety & Security
 - The combination Public Safety/Apartment Managers meeting featured HPD officers discussing gang activity.
 - The Board approved renewal of the patrol services with Harris County Constable Precinct 1.
