The Near Northwest Management District (NNMD) Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, June 20, 2019. The agenda included the following items:

- The Board received reports from the District's assessment advisor and bookkeeper.
- Branding
 - Phase 2 of the monument markers program is in fabrication and moving forward.
 - Designs for the mini murals are being finalized and assigned locations for installation.
- Economic and Business Development
 - The Committee recommended, and the Board adopted a resolution of support for the TxDOT Safe Routes to School project application that, if funded, will link neighborhoods along North Houston Rosslyn to Ermel and Eiland Elementary Schools.
- White Oak Conference Center
 - The pilot program for maintaining "back of curb" areas and clearing gutters on major roadways is showing success.
 - White Oak Pool membership have increased.
- Membership Committee
 - The Board appointed Jerry Skweres, President of Forged Products, Inc., to fill the unexpired term of Position 1.
- Public Safety & Security
 - National Night Out is coming up on October 1 and planning is well underway.
 - Ruby Glass will be leaving NNMD after 10 years of service. The District will host a reception in her honor on June 28 from 4:00 – 8:00 pm at the District office.
